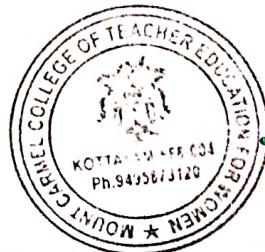

3. Conducted UGC sponsored Add on certificate courses in Computer application and Counsellor Training (20 credits)

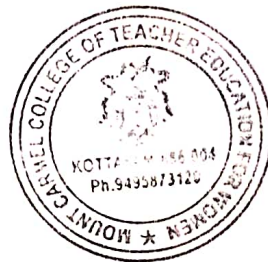

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4. Started five new value added courses namely Understanding India, Drama and Theatre Arts, Yoga and fitness, Digital Skills for prospective Teachers and Life Skills education of 30 hours duration.
5. Interface with the Heads and Senior teachers of the practice teaching schools was conducted on 13-10-2022
6. Signed new MoU's with different Institutions.
7. Renovation of the B.Ed block was completed. A new biogas plant, waste management system, solar panels and office automation software were installed during the year
8. The new NSS unit 246 of the college was inaugurated on 09-11-2022
9. Several orientation programmes and workshops were arranged for students. Moodle training programme was conducted for the faculty and staff on 09-11-2022. Training in using newly installed Office automation software was given to the administrative staff on 02-07-2022.
10. Anti-Drug addiction week was observed from 28th October to 1st November 2022. Various programmes such as rally, flash mob, human chain, debate, short film and literary competitions were conducted on the theme
11. Analysis of the results of the B.Ed and M.Ed Degree examinations (2020-2022 batch) were done. Among the 50 B.Ed students, 36 secured A+, 12 secured A and 2 secured B. 11 students secured first ten rank positions. Among the 11 M.Ed students, 1 secured A+ and 9 secured A.
12. M.Ed students participated and presented papers in the two day national seminar on NEP conducted by SNM Training College, Moothakunnam from 20th to 21st October 2022, International Conference conducted by St. John of God College of Special Education from 22nd to 24th 2023 and in the national seminar conducted by School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University from 1st to 2nd March 2023.
13. Students participated in the online Inspirational Talks on "Anxieties and Aspirations of an Emerging Young India" by Professor Sandeep Shastri, Vice Chancellor of Jagran Lake City University on 13th August 2022 and "Expectations of and from Young citizens" by Derek O'Brien, Member of Rajyasabha on 16th August 2022 conducted by Loreto College, Kolkata.
14. Various Extension activities were conducted during the year
15. CARMEX 2023 - exhibition on teaching aids and Carmel Fest- Inter school competitions for the students of the practice teaching schools were conducted on 22-02-2023 and 23-02-2023.
16. Three days Social life wellness programme (Pathway) for the minority students was conducted in the Institution in Collaboration with Minority Department, Govt. of Kerala from 07-02-2023 to 09-02-2023
17. Carmel Graphics (Volume 11) the peer reviewed annual journal of the institution was published in April 2023.
18. Feedback on curriculum from the stake holders and comprehensive evaluation on the performance of student teachers during Internship were collected, analysed and further actions were taken



19. Medical Camp was conducted in the institution in collaboration with Medical Centre Hospital, Kottayam on 29-03-2023

21. Majority of our students have qualified KTET/CTET/SET examinations
22. Our students participated in various intercollegiate, university level competitions and secured several prizes in sports and literary events.
