MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Agreement is made on 3rd of June 2021 between Mount Carmel College of Teacher Education for Women, Kottayam, Kerala represented by its Principal Dr. Mary Sheba Jose as the first party and between Sr. Alphonsas U P School, Chennamattom, represented by its Headmistress Ms.Kunjumol Antony as the second party.

This Memorandum of Understanding is intended to promote co-operation between Mount Carmel College of Teacher Education for Women, Kottayam and Sr. Alphonsas U P School, Chennamattom, Kerala represented by the Management recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions, hereby agree to enter into this agreement for the following purpose.

1. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational cooperation, establish a collaborative programme in teacher and student exchange between the two parties and to co-operate in their mutual interest for a range of higher educational activities.

2. AREAS OF COOPERATION

Subject to the availability, resources and approval of the authorized representatives or Heads of the Institutions Mount Carmel College of Teacher Education for Women and Sr. Alphonsas U P School, Chennamattom agree to develop the following collaborative

i) Sharing of human resources in scholarly pursuits

- ii) Addressing the needs of the learners- Free tuition/ Remedial classes/Skill development programmes
- iii) Organize Capacity enhancement and Student Development Programmes

iv) **Extension Activities**

- v) **Best Practices**
- vi) Collaboration in the area of Education and Teacher Training
- Social action (community development Programmes) vii)
- Exchange of information and teaching learning materials viii)
- ix) Organization of Awareness classes/ Lectures/Seminars
- To share Library and Laboratory facilities X)
- Any other area of mutual interest that may emerge in future xi)

3. **IMPLEMENTATION**

- a) All programs or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the programme of activity as the need may arise.
- b) Each of the participating institutions shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the parties.
- c) The parties will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Intellectual property rights of work carried out at each partner institution shall normally vest with respective institution.

RIGHTS AND DUTIES 5.

- a) The Host Institution is committed to counseling and supporting faculty and students on exchange through advice on academic and administrative procedures, as well as to foster their integration, inviting and encouraging guest students to become involved in student life.
- b) The institutions shall act as facilitators, but they will have no obligation what so ever in terms of the actions, behaviours or financial aspects of the students / participants involved in the exchange.
- c) The students /participants shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as regular students/faculty, and shall observe the norms and rules of the Host Institution and the Host State.

d) Any violation of the laws of the receiving State and/or the rules of the Host Institution by an exchange participant' shall be grounds for the immediate termination of the privileges in the context of this Agreement.

e) The host institution agrees to assist to provide boarding, lodging and necessities and to

provide workspace, library and laboratory facilities as appropriate

6. **AUTONOMY:**

This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.

7. DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of both the Institutions for a period of Five Years and is subject to revision of modification by mutual agreement.

8. AMENDMENTS

a) This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both the institution.

b) In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities both the

institution agrees to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.

c) Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this Agreement, the institutions shall endeavor to exercise best efforts to negotiate their differences.

9. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before termination date, provided that such termination shall not affect the completion of any programme or activity underway at the time the notice of termination is given.

10. APPROVAL

In agreement with the above terms of participation, the authorized representatives of Mount Carmel College of Teacher Education for Women, Kottayam and Sr. Alphonsas U P School, Chennamattom, hereby affix signatures.
