

The Institution arranges a series of orientation sessions to provide essential information about the institution, its policies, and procedures, academic and support services, as well as to help students set academic and personal goals.

One Week Student Induction Programme

The B. Ed and M. Ed programmes for the academic year 2022-2023 commenced on 12th September 2022 and 17th November 2022 respectively. One week Student Orientation Programme was systematically conducted for the newly admitted B.Ed and M.Ed students in the Institution. The programme help newly admitted students to understand the academic, social, and cultural aspects of the institution, helping their smooth transition into the new environment. Several topics discussed includes introduction to the institution, its vision and mission, foundress of the institution, Programme orientation, familiarization of Programme outcomes and course outcomes, campus tour, add on courses and value added courses, Self study courses, functioning of committees and cells, student support services, scholarships, college anthem and prayer songs, code of conduct, rules and regulations, extension activity, interaction with alumni, clubs and associations, facilities and achievements of the institution, entry level assessment tests, mentoring and remedial teaching.

An orientation to the new batch of B.Ed. students was given on 12th September 2022. College Principal, Staff Secretary and the faculty of our college jointly welcomed new batch of students during the programme. 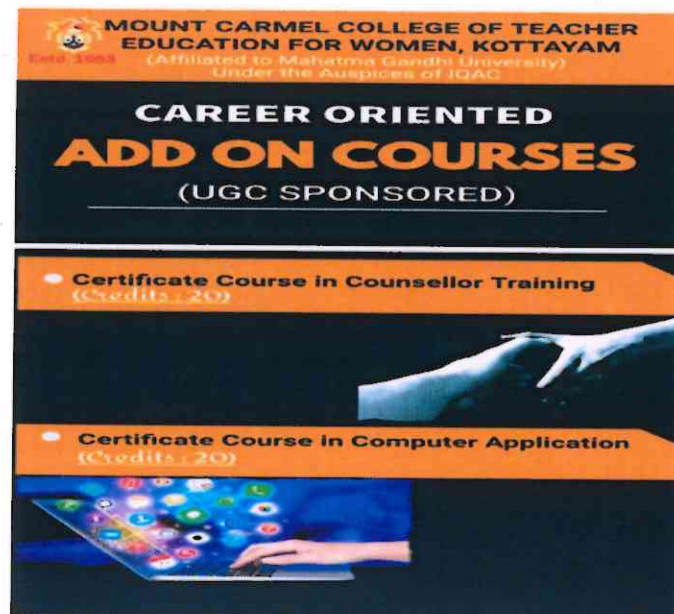
