
Strengthening Existing educational Practices

- Organic farming was promoted and set a vegetable garden in the adopted school which contributes for midday meal scheme.



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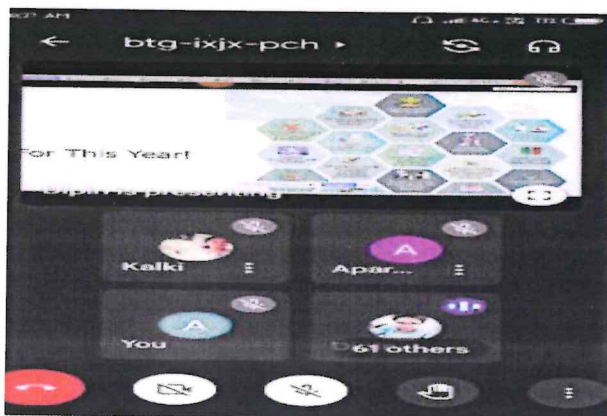




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- Students are encouraged to contribute their ideas in Young Innovation Programme (YIP) of Government of Kerala. Students presented their ideas.

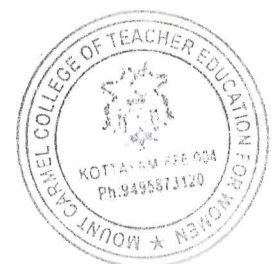


The teaching learning materials and aids prepared such as album, dictionary, workbooks, models, innovative charts were shared with the school teachers to strengthen the teaching learning experience
