

#### **REPORT OF OUTREACH ACTIVITIES 2020-21**

#### 1. Community survey - The study on Impact of Covid 19

The study on Impact of Covid 19 was done in almost 20 villages mainly adjoining to Kottayam, EranakulamIdukki ,andPathanamthita Districts of Kerala on 24-06-2020. study was mainly through a survey method with students of our institution and each students were asked to conduct the same study in their own villages or municipality. In this situation of spreading the pandemic the complete survey analysis was done virtually through Google Forms. The Study focused on ten questions related to activities adopted by the villages to fight against the pandemic Covid19. About 337 different responses were collected and analysed in Google Forms and each responses were uploaded in Excel Form.

From the study its very much clear that all villages and municipalities of the districts mentioned above played a crucial role to face this pandemic and the public themselves take their own responsibility to fight against this. But it is noted that some percent of people are unaware about their own surroundings.

A descriptive study on Impact Of 1918 Pandemic (H1N1) were also done. Dr.Lissykoshy and Sr.Bindhumol T co-ordinated the studies.





#### 1. Flood Relief Camp in community- 16-08-2018 & 26-08-2018


