


1.6 Rally on awareness regarding 'no to drugs' - 28/10/2022


1.7 Flash Mob on 31st October, 2022






4.3 Indian Constitution Day' 25th November 2022


12. National level online workshop on VENTEL Action Plan in collaboration with MGNCRE, Ministry of Education, 21-10-2020






